Distinguish Fact from Opinion (2)

- Reading is the **active process** of understanding print and graphic texts.
 - **Reading is a thinking process.**
 - Effective readers know that when they read, what they read is supposed to make sense.

Distinguish Fact from Opinion (2)

- **Fact is a statement that can be verified – that is proven to be true or false.**
 - **Opinion is an expression of judgement or belief about something. This information cannot be proved or disproved.**
-

Distinguish Fact from Opinion (2)

- **Fact relies on observation or research.**
- **Opinion is based on assumption.**

Reptiles are a type of animal classification that live on land.

If you see a black cat, that's a sign that something bad will happen to you.

Distinguish Fact from Opinion (2)

- The fact is an objective reality whereas **opinion** is a **subjective statement**.
 - **Opinion is not supported by any evidence.**
 - **Opinion represents a perception about something.**

Distinguish Fact from Opinion (2)

- **Facts can change anybody's opinion, but vice versa is not possible.**
- Facts are real information and so it cannot be challenged or debated, but if we talk about **opinions, they can be debated.**

Distinguish Fact from Opinion (2)

- **B-Y-O-B** is a short way of saying, “**Bring Your Own Bottle.**”
 - The letters **BYOB** are often found at the bottom of a written invitation to a simple social event or gathering of friends.
-

Distinguish Fact from Opinion (2)

- For example, let's say I had a New Year's Eve party. I might include on the invitation, "Please come to my party and BYOB." The bottle each person brings is what the person wants to drink at the party or wants to share.

Distinguish Fact from Opinion (2)

- However, an invitation to a special event – such as a wedding --would never say BYOB.
 - An invitation to an official or very special event often has other letters written at the bottom. The letters are R-S-V-P.

Distinguish Fact from Opinion (2)

- These letters represent the French expression, *“Repondez S’il Vous Plait.”* In English the words mean, *“Respond If It Pleases You.”* Americans use the letters as a short way to say, *“Please answer this invitation.”*

 - **desertification** (n.)
 - **dessert** (n.) sweet food eaten at the end of a meal

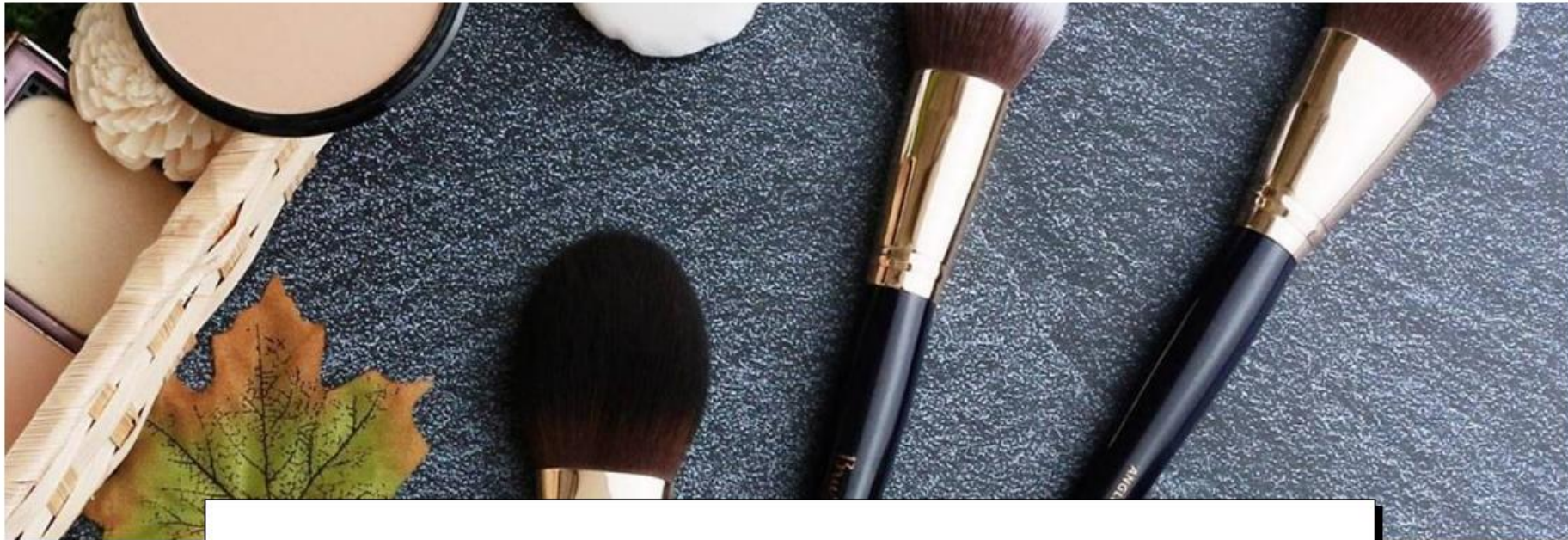



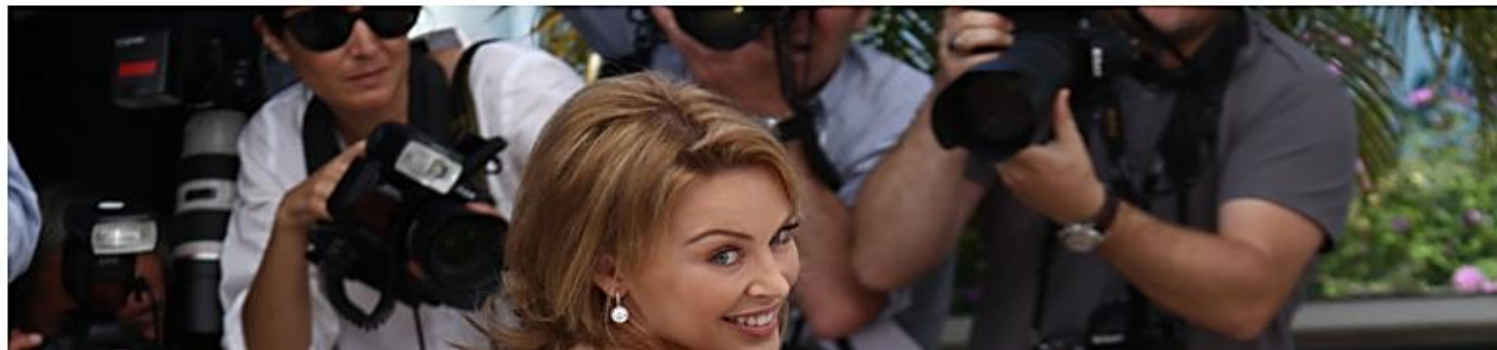
