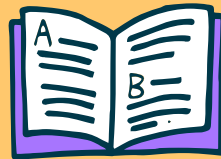
One in five COVID-19 patients develop mental illness within 90 days: US study

- LONDON: Many COVID-19 survivors are likely to be at greater risk of developing mental illness, **psychiatrists** said on Monday (Nov 9),

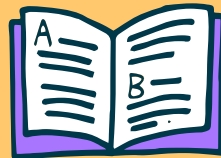

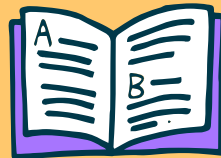

- Anxiety, depression and insomnia were most common among recovered COVID-19 patients in the study who developed mental health problems,

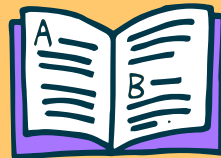

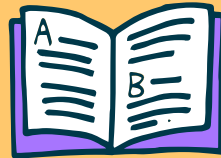
