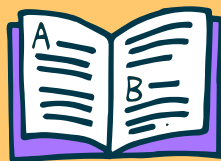

Learning Vocabulary in Context (1)

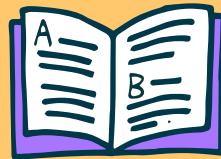
- **context** (n.) surrounding words
- **Learning vocabulary in context** means that you learn new words when you are reading or listening.
- You learn a new word by seeing how it is used in a sentence.





Learning Vocabulary in Context (1)

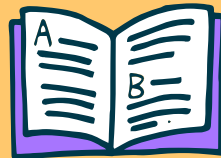
- **Context clues** are hints found within a sentence, paragraph, or passage that a reader can use to understand the meanings of new or unfamiliar words.





Learning Vocabulary in Context (1)

- **Four Types of Context Clues**
 - 1: Definition or Restatement
 - 2: Synonym
 - 3: Antonym /Opposite/Contrast
 - 4: Example or Explanation

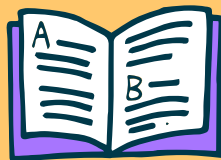




Learning Vocabulary in Context (1)

- Clues to definition include “that is,” commas, dashes, and parentheses.

People spend hours in **gridlock** – that is, traffic so horrible that it simply doesn't move. There is a **drawback**, a disadvantage, to that idea.

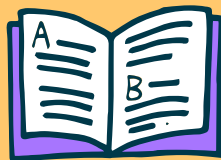




Learning Vocabulary in Context (1)

Clues to definition include “that is,” commas, dashes, and parentheses.

The downtown shopping area is now a **pedestrian zone** – in other words, an area for walkers only, no cars.

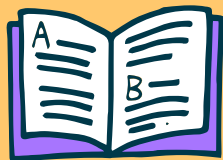




Learning Vocabulary in Context (1)

Results on these exams affect the **entire** family because there is high **status**, or social position, for a whole family in which children have high test scores.

The mountain pass was a **tortuous** road, winding and twisting like a snake around the trees of the mountainside.

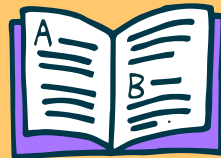
This situation is a **conundrum**, a puzzle that's difficult to solve.

- There are many more schools in cities than in **rural** areas.



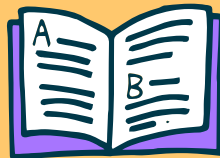


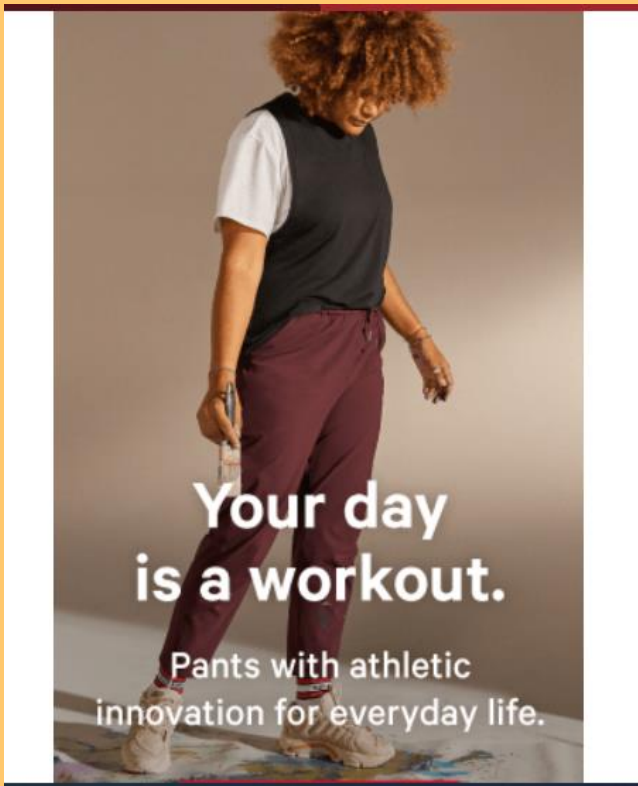
Learning Vocabulary in Context (1)

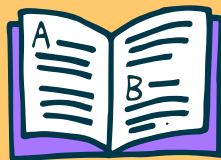

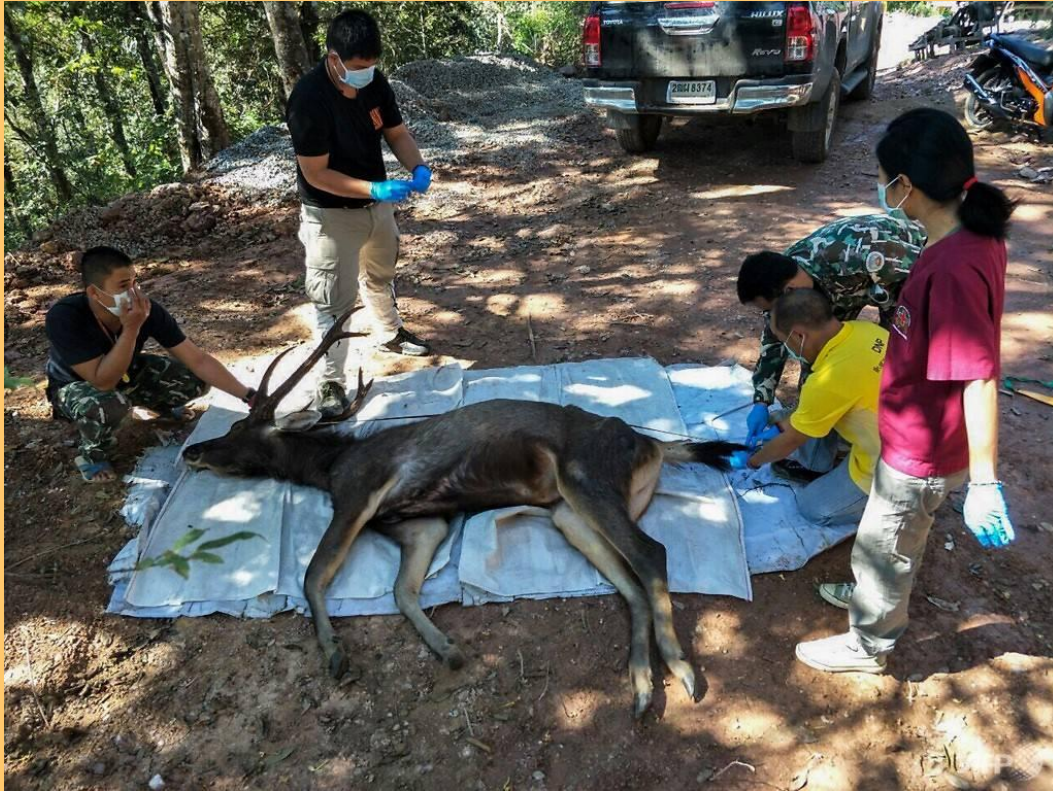
Learning Vocabulary in Context (1)
