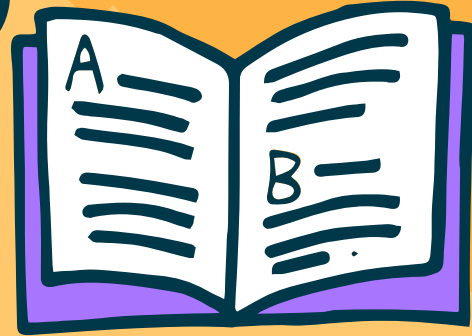

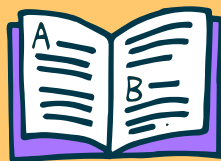

Learning Vocabulary in Context (5)

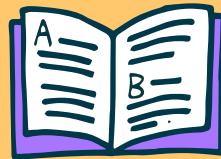
- **context** (n.) surrounding words
- **Learning vocabulary in context** means that you learn new words when you are reading or listening.
- You learn a new word by seeing how it is used in a sentence.





Learning Vocabulary in Context (5)

- **Context clues** are hints found within a sentence, paragraph, or passage that a reader can use to understand the meanings of new or unfamiliar words.

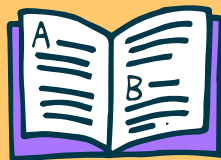




Learning Vocabulary in Context (5)

Four Types of Context Clues

- 1: Definition or Restatement
- 2: Synonym
- 3: Antonym /Opposite/Contrast
- 4: Example or Explanation

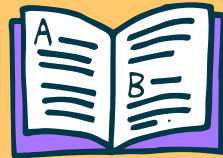
- There are many different types of reusable water bottles, ranging from plastic to stainless steel, and there are pros and cons for each.

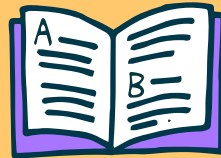
- The air inside many homes, office buildings, and schools is full of **pollutants**: chemicals, mold, bacteria, smoke, and gases.

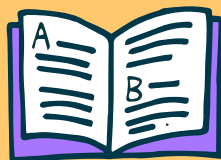

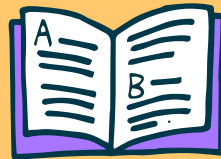
