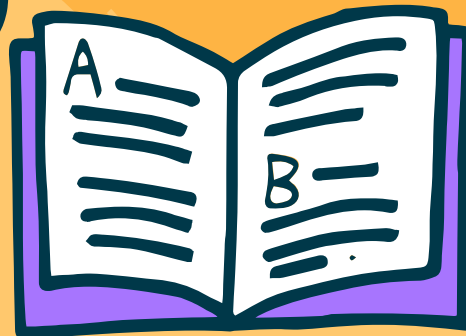

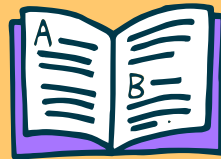

What is lifelong learning and why is it important?

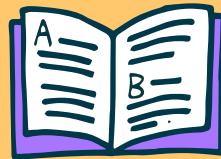
Lifelong learning refers to the process of gaining knowledge and learning new skills throughout your life.





What is lifelong learning and why is it important?

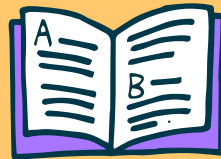
Lifelong learning is about creating and maintaining a positive attitude to learning both for personal and professional development.





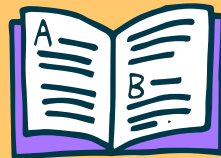
What is lifelong learning and why is it important?

Lifelong learning can enhance our understanding of the world around us, provide us with more and better opportunities and improve our quality of life.





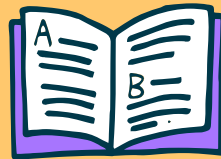

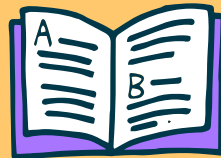
Characteristics of a Lifelong Learner

Develop good reading habits.





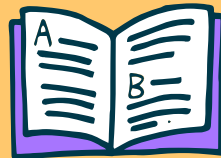

Share your skills and knowledge.

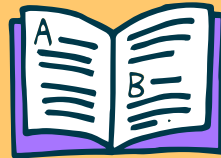
Stay curious.

Lifelong learning is about staying active and staying curious in your mind, body and spirit.



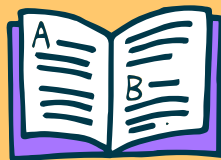
