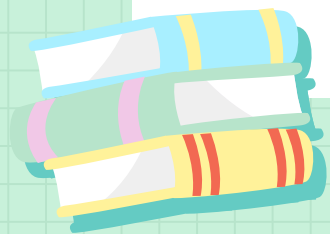

Learning Vocabulary (1)



- ❑ **read hear speak write**
- ❑ part of speech, meaning, pronunciation,
- ❑ collocation, spelling, example sentence

Learning Vocabulary (1)

- ❑ **address** (n., v.)
- ❑ What's your email **address**?
- ❑ We'll **address** that question at the next meeting.

Learning Vocabulary (1)

- ❑ **sentence** (v.)
- ❑ Chinese national **sentenced** to US prison after pleading guilty to stealing trade secrets.

Learning Vocabulary (1)



- ❑ She **collects** stamps.
- ❑ It took a long time to **collect** data.
- ❑ The data **collection** process took a long time.

Learning Vocabulary (1)

- ❑ **ability (n.)** the physical or mental power or skill needed to do something
- ❑ Her teammates respect her **abilities**.

Learning Vocabulary (1)

- She has children in her class of very **mixed abilities** (= different levels of skill or intelligence).

Learning Vocabulary (1)



- ❑ Synonyms for **ability**: capability capacity
- ❑ competence intelligence qualification
- ❑ skill strength talent
- ❑ She has a great **capacity** for hard work.

- ❑ Singers can prove their **competence** by performing well in the concert.
- ❑ **competency-based** approach

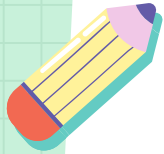

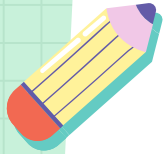


- ❑ **Environmentalists** say a **critical** factor in the city's **pollution** is its **population**.

- **Karuna** is more like compassion and pity; it's about feeling of others, recognizing what suffering is like.

- ❑ **Mudita** is translated as **sympathetic joy**; the joy we find in the happiness of **others**. The joy we find in the beauty of the goodness of others. **It is an antidote to jealousy.**
