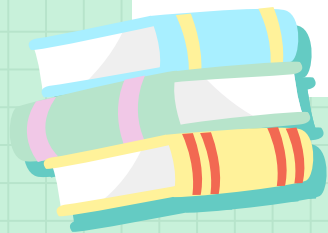
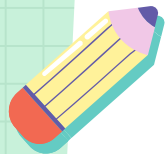

- ❑ She is a **financial analyst** (= someone who studies financial investments).

Learning Vocabulary (3)

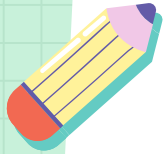


- ❑ **analysis** (n.) the study of something in detail:
- ❑ They took blood and urine specimens for **analysis**.

Learning Vocabulary (3)



- ❑ **critical** (adj.) important, serious and dangerous
- ❑ **critically** (adv.) very badly or dangerously
- ❑ **endangered** (adj.) unsafe and insecure

Learning Vocabulary (3)

- ❑ SINGAPORE: Thirteen **critically endangered** turtles belonging to a species not seen in its **natural habitat** since 2009 have been ‘**successfully**’

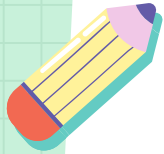


- ❑ arrive (v.) arrival (n.)

- ❑ **infection** (n.)
- ❑ He's on antibiotics for an ear **infection**.
- ❑ White blood cells help defend the body against **infection**.

Learning Vocabulary (3)

- ❑ **infectious** (adj.) infectious diseases
- ❑ These viruses affect children and are highly **infectious**.
- ❑ We are advised to **disinfect** the area to reduce the risk of **infection**.

Learning Vocabulary (3)




- ❑ **infect** (v.)
- ❑ A single mosquito can **infect** a large number of people.
- ❑ This virus **infected** thousands of computers within days.

Learning Vocabulary (3)



- ❑ **infect** (v.) **disinfect** (v.) = to clean something with a liquid that destroy bacteria
- ❑ Chlorine is used to **disinfect** water.

Learning Vocabulary (3)

- 
- ❑ **disinfect** (v.) = **to clean**
 - ❑ Synonyms: **sterilize, purify, decontaminate, clean**

Learning Vocabulary (3)



- ❑ **exponential** (adj.) **exponentially** (adv.)
=growing or increasing very rapidly
- ❑ We are looking for **exponential** growth in our investment.
- ❑ Our business is growing **exponentially**.

Learning Vocabulary (3)



- **outbreak** (n.)
 - Ms Lam urged people to avoid gatherings ahead of next week's Lunar New Year as the territory also tackles **an outbreak** of the Omicron variant.

- ❑ **variant** (n.) something that differs from a standard or type
- ❑ The Delta **variant** of COVID-19 was spreading across the globe.
