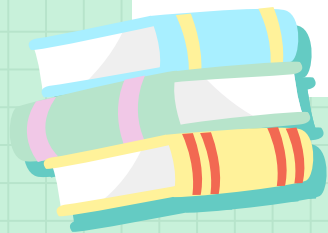

## Learning Vocabulary (7)



- ❑ **The best way** to increase our vocabulary is to **read everything**: newspapers, magazines, books, short stories, novels, or textbooks.
- ❑ **Read widely**

## Learning Vocabulary (7)



- ❑ The second suggestion is **to be alert to new words that we hear or read.**
- ❑ We should listen thoughtfully and carefully to skilled speakers in order to learn new words.

## Learning Vocabulary (7)



- ❑ In our reading, we are likely to **encounter unfamiliar words**. It is **better not to look them up in the dictionary immediately** because this will interrupt the flow of our comprehension.

- The whole family was **present**. (here)
- I gave them a wedding **present**. (gift)

## Learning Vocabulary (7)



- As the **ultimate authoritative reference**, the Pali Canon provides the **standards** or **criteria** for judging whether a given teaching or way of practice truly belongs to **Buddhism**.

## Learning Vocabulary (7)



- ❑ **authoritative** = true, reliable, authentic
- ❑ The evidence she uses is highly **authoritative**.
- ❑ **authority** = a decision-making organization or government department

## Learning Vocabulary (7)



- It is thus the **duty** and **responsibility** of all **Buddhists** to **preserve** and **protect** the Pali Canon, which is **crucial** for the **survival** of **Buddhism**, and hence also for the **welfare** and **happiness** of the world.

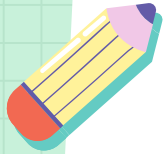
- gender vs sex

- Sex describes the biological sex a person was assigned at birth.

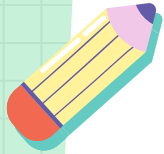

## Learning Vocabulary (7)

- ❑ “**Transmasculine**” is an umbrella term that refers to people who were assigned female at birth but identify with masculinity.
- ❑ It’s often abbreviated as “**transmasc.**”

## Learning Vocabulary (7)



- ❑ **Transmasculine** are people who were assigned female at birth (AFAB) but identify more with a masculine identity.

- ❑ In other words, **transmasculine** is a broad term that includes a few different groups of people.

## Learning Vocabulary (7)



- ❑ Researchers in Minnesota **analyzed data** from students across the state in grades eight, nine and 11, finding that a significant portion of the **youth population** identified

## Learning Vocabulary (7)

- ❑ Other research in the field has found that while young people report that **bullying**, **harassment** and **micro aggressions** are common in schools,

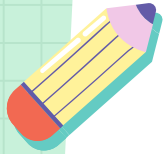
- ❑ **non-homosexuals**, it is often used by homosexuals themselves as a positive term.
